Year 2012 Restricted Golf Course Times

- Monday** - No restrictions except when large outings are scheduled. Check calendar on General Manager's door and/or bulletin board for a schedule of possible outings throughout the year.
- Tuesday** - Women have priority off first tee between 8:30 - 9:30 am and from 3:00 - 5:30 pm. (Policy in effect from Memorial Day to Labor Day)
- Wednesday** - Men only first tee from 11:00 - 4:00 pm. (21 years of age and older)
- Thursday** - Open play until commencement of Thursday Evening League play April through August. Course needs to be cleared for shotgun at 5:30 pm.
- Friday** - Senior League has 9:00 am shotgun (Late April through mid August). *Course is still open but a group playing that morning will be mixed with league play.*
- Saturday and Sunday** - Golf course open with no restrictions on play except the day of a scheduled golf event. Check bulletin board for golf events that would restrict weekend play.

Tee Times - Golf members may make tee times for Wednesdays, weekends and holidays up to 7 days in advance. Lodge members only may make tee times up to 24 hours in advance.

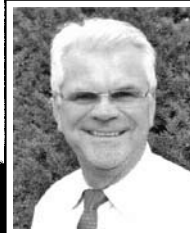
