My name is Terry Anderson and I am excited to oversee the golf operation as your PGA Golf Professional this season and for many more to come. For those members who are not familiar with me, let me brief you. I am a 19 year PGA of America member. I was the Director of Golf at the University of Iowa's Finkbine Golf Course from 1994-2007. While working in that capacity I was recognized by the Iowa Golf Association as its Golf Professional of the Year in 1997. In 2004, I was honored as the Golf Professional of the Year by my peers in the Iowa PGA Section. In addition to the golf operation duties at Finkbine, I was also the Head Men's Golf Coach during this time. My Hawkeye teams won 9 team championships. I coached 6 individuals to medalist honors in tournaments. I coached 7 Academic All-Americans and 37 Academic All Big Ten athletes in my 13 year coaching career. My 1994-95 team qualified for the NCAA Championship and finished 26th in the country.

I promise to provide you with the professional customer service that would be expected from a member of a private club. I am employed by the City of Iowa City in a management position so my time spent in the club may not coincide with yours. However, I will have the staff working at the club in the golf operation area trained in a manner that will be a reflection of me. The Art of Cup Cutting

From the days of old Tom Morris greens keeping at St. Andrews to today's art and science of golf course maintenance, changing cups on the putting green has remained the same. The hole cutting tool is a sharpened eight inch steel cylinder four inches in diameter attached to a twenty-four inch steel bar with an eighteen inch wooden T handle, a simple tool for one of the most difficult jobs on the golf course. Of the forty years spent on golf courses, I can only remember about six people who excelled at the task, yours truly not being one of them.

Leaning pins, ragged edges, unfair locations, no variety, low and high plugs when filling the old hole are a few obstacles you deal with on each green. Some greens are soil (each a different type), some are sand. One day the greens are hard. Another day, wet from too much rain and golfer pushing you can also lead to problems. Most of these problems can be corrected with patience and proper training except for one; cutting the hole straight so the pin is not leaning.

A good sense of balance and a feel for the green contour are a must to get the cup perpendicular to the green. A golfing background is necessary when deciding holes for general play, tournaments or a crowded outing. Wind and direction of play into the green are key considerations.

I have learned what employees have this deft ability (very few), those that can cut six out of nine (the norm) and some that cannot master it (assign them to other tasks).

The location of the hole is the last thing a golfer remembers as he picks his ball out the cup, hopefully not after a three putt.

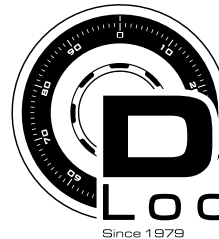

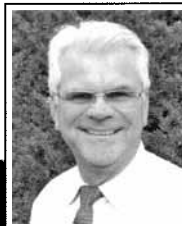
