Tournament Schedule and Sunday Events

The Golf Committee has been asked to address the following concerns about the Year 2013 golf event schedule:

Ryder Cup Play Date

The tournament schedule is accurate as posted as of May 1. The Ryder Cup play date was always to be on a Saturday, we just made a mistake when creating the formal schedule. This was corrected about two weeks ago. The revised schedule has been posted in various places around the clubhouse. The Gold Committee extends apologies for any concern or difficulty this may have created for our members.

Sunday Events

There are five Sunday club tournaments, excluding the two day championship events that require a Sunday final day. Of these, three are in the fall during football season. The Golf Committee is of the opinion that Saturday events during football season are historically not well attended. People want to watch their college football. The Hawkeyes have a heavy early season home schedule; six of the first nine games are at home, making Saturday golf events not advisable. The first two away games are Minnesota and Iowa State; both are traveled to by local fans. There are no realistic Saturdays available in late August through the middle of October. We do have a Saturday tournament scheduled for October 12, an open date for Iowa. Iowa plays again at home on October 26 and November 2.

Just a reminder that our "Three for Free" promotion continues. We have a couple of members knocking on the door with two new recruits. One more proposed membership and their dues are free.

Elks Lodge 590 Pool Rules & Policies

1. ALL food and/or beverages consumed in the pool area MUST be purchased from the Club. No coolers.
2. Children under the age of 12 must NOT be left unattended by their parents. (Lifeguards are there to work, not to baby sit.)
3. No gum chewing allowed in the pool area.
4. No band-aids in the pool.
5. Swimsuits are only acceptable attire for pool use. No T-shirts allowed in the pool. (T-shirts only have an SPF of 5, a good sunscreen is a much better idea.) No cutoffs. No aqua socks in the pool. (They are the second largest source of contaminates in swimming pools.)
6. No large rafts or inflatable toys allowed in the pool. Small balls, water rings, are okay. No inflatable devices in the deep end EVER.
7. No tennis balls, footballs, etc. The only objects allowed are "nerf" or soft objects only.
8. There is to be no swimming in the deep end without free swim called (e.g.: Lifeguards can only allow either swimming or diving, NOT both.)
9. Children are allowed in the deep end only after they exhibit the ability to swim the length of the deep end twice IN GOOD FORM.
10. Patrons must swim directly to the side ladder to get out of the deep end. Not back underneath to diving board.
11. One person on the diving board at a time.
12. One bounce on the diving board then into the water. This means you cannot drop to buttocks and then into the water either feet first or hands first.
13. No running is allowed on the pool deck.
14. No horse playing or chicken fights.
15. No back dives or flips from the side of the pool.
16. NO GLASS containers of any kind in the pool deck area.
17. No hanging on the diving board.
18. No hanging on the ropes in the pool.
19. Adult swim will be called every hour and will last ten minutes. During this time all children (under age 18 years) must clear the water completely - this means get all the way out of the water.
20. Everyone MUST sign in when entering the pool area.
21. A \$5.00 per person fee must be paid or charged by all Regular Lodge Members who are not Season Swimming Members and their guest.
22. Nannies and baby sitters are considered members of the family of pool members and will not need to pay the swim fee.
23. Patrons must shower before entering the pool.
24. Lifeguards are the FINAL authority in the pool areas. This means that the guards can sit people out of the pool for ten minutes, the day, the week, etc.

Crompton Finished Second

Regina seventh-grader Mary Crompton competed in the Elk National Free Throw Contest Saturday, April 20th, in Springfield, MA. Competing in the Girls 12-13 year-old division against 11 other regional champions from across the U.S., she hit 24 of 25 free throws to tie for first with the defending national champion; she then hit 5 of 5, then 4 of 5 in consecutive tiebreakers, to finish as the National

Runner-up. Mary averaged 94% this year from the free throw line, including victories in the local, district, state and regional contests. May is the daughter of members Terry and Betsy Crompton, her brother David, is one of our lifeguards. She has competed in the Elk's Hoop Shoot for the last six years and hates to see her time come to an end. Lodge 590 thanks Mary for representing us so well.

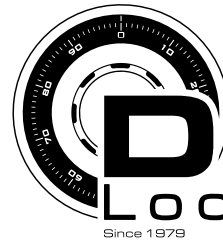
