## General Manager's Report

It will be a very busy August at Lodge 590. First we need to thank Jason Tjarks and Mike Morony for their efforts in getting our pool pump fully operational. Without their help we would have gone longer than four days of being shut down. In response to the loss of swimming days, the Board of Directors has approved allowing all Pool Members to bring up to four guests at no charge the weekend of August 15-17<sup>th</sup>.

Golf course wise we are hosting three outings this month. Monday August 8<sup>th</sup> is the annual Glen Roberts/ Iowa City Hospice outing. This is a double shotgun which will close the course until 5 p.m.

Monday the 11<sup>th</sup> Blackstone restaurant will have an outing with a 1:00 p.m. shotgun. Then, on Saturday August 16<sup>th</sup> we will host the Lucy Jane Roth Medical Fund outing. ### Irrigation Project:

One of this year's fund-raising efforts was a new irrigation control system which was installed on June 2; It's on the green between #1 fairway and #9 green. Due to weather and flooding of the pump-house, it's first use was Wednesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. Everything is working as it should.

### Ash Tree Project:

Another fund raising project. Ash trees have been removed from behind #1 green and between holes #2 & #6 fairways. Committee is currently reviewing quotations and selecting tree species. Planting new trees is planned for September pending Board of Directors approval.

### Hole #9 project:

A tentative plan has been developed for networking bunker area forward/left of green and leveling lower tee box. Organizing contractor to perform work in September pending approval from Board of Directors.

### Flood Damage Status:

The pump-house came through flooding with no significant damage. Pumps and motors reinstalled on irrigation system operational as of July 23. We are working as quickly as possible to get the rear #5 tees back in play.

### July 1-24 Golf Course Flooding Report:

2014 was a repeat of the flood of 2013 with the loss of two trees on hole 5 and a water hazard on the side of 2<sup>nd</sup> green. We will begin re-seeding August 15<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. Three weeks of not having our Iowa River pump station to furnish water to the course could have been a disaster with a normal hot July. Luckily we were in a cool weather pattern. A lot of damage was done to wet areas and wilting fairways due to cart damage. Pay attention to cart signs and clubhouse postings!

Special thanks to Jason Nicholson and Jason Tjarks for use of specialized equipment from Accurate Automotive to help with evacuation and set-up of the pump station. Thank you to all of our Elks who also helped with the flood, windstorm and sand traps.

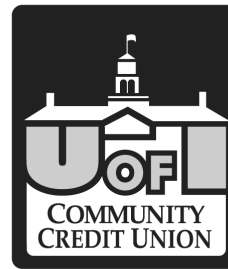

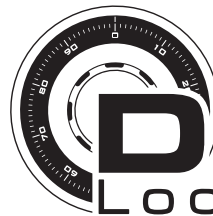
