Golfers, be sure to mark your calendar and plan to play in the following July golf events:

July 7nd – Women’s Super Tuesday Event. This is a Guest Day Event. Bring a guest, a non-Elk member please, and their green fee for the day is free! Cart fee, if needed by guest, will be charged. Entry fee is \$25, prizes and dinner provided. Signup sheet is posted in proshop.

July 11th – Hit and Giggle Couple’s Event. Make up your own group of four and get out and play. Shotgun start at 1:00PM. Signup sheet is posted in proshop. B.F. Burt will perform after the event and food will be available.

July 18th – Women’s Club Championship. 18-hole stroke play event is open to all women Elk members with USGA handicap. At end of play, golfers will be placed in flights based on net score with prizes being awarded within each flight. Lowest gross score is Women’s Club Champion! You must be a golf member to be awarded Club Champion prize.

July 25th & 26th – Men’s Senior Club Championship. Two-day 36-hole stroke play event contested on our Gold/Black tees is open to golf members 50 years of age or older with a USGA handicap. Must be 50 by July 24, 2015 to qualify. After Saturday play is completed, golfers will be placed in flights based on net score. We award prizes based on position within each flight after completion of Sunday’s play. Lowest two-day gross score is Men’s Senior Club Champion!

July 25th & 26th – Men’s Super-Senior Club Championship. Two-day 36-hole stroke play event is offered to golf members with USGA handicap 70 years of age or older. Must be 70 by July 24, 2015. Players between 70 and 74 years of age will play White/Gold tees. Players 75 and older will play White/White tees.

NOTES FROM THE PRO

The golf course is still in fantastic shape and is just looking for players to use it. This months events are July 11th Couples "Hit & Giggle", July 18th is the Women's Club Championship and July 25 & 26 is the Senior Men's Club Championship. Sign up sheets and information will be posted on the board for these events in the pro shop. Make room on your calendars to compete in these events and enjoy spending time with your fellow Elk's members.

We had 51 juniors ages 6-12 for golf camp in June. We had a great week of weather for the camp and the future looks bright for new players enjoying our golf course and learning life's lesson's while playing the game.
