BY-LAW CHANGE

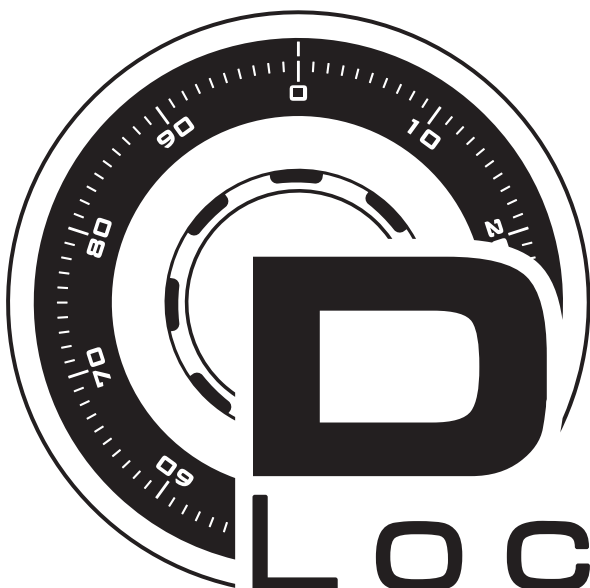
