The golf course continues to be in excellent condition thanks to our Grounds Staff and Mother Nature. Plan to get out to the Lodge and participate in the following events scheduled for June and July:

Saturday, June 4th – We will be hosting Iowa City Golf Association's (ICGA) Two-Person Ryder Cup Tournament, a great opportunity to showcase our club to the community. This 27-hole flighted event is open to all golfers living or working in Johnson County. Find a partner and sign-up at www.iowacitygolf.com. Event rescheduled due to poor weather when originally scheduled.

Tuesday, June 7th – Ladies Super Tuesday event.

Saturday, June 18th – Junior Golf Championship will play contested. Please sign up your junior golfer in the pro shop. Open to children of Elk members who are 17-years of age or under.

Saturday and Sunday, June 25th & 26th – Elks Lodge 590 Men's Club Championship will be contested. Champion is player with lowest gross-score over 36-holes of play. We also play an individual net-score event as part of tournament. Club Championship is open to men golf members only. Net-score play requires a USGA handicap.

Tuesday, July 5th or 12th – Ladies Super Tuesday event. Consult pro shop for which Tuesday it's to be played.

Saturday, July 9th – Hit & Giggle Couples event. This is a team event, 3-couples comprise a team. You will play best shot with men and women alternating shots. You may bring guests to this fun-filled event, a great opportunity to introduce our club to others.

Saturday and Sunday, July 23rd & 24th – Elks Lodge 590 Senior Men's Club Championship to be held. You must be 50 years of age or older by June 23rd to participate. Champion is player with lowest gross-score over 36-holes of play. We also play an individual net-score event as part of tournament. Club Championship is open to men golf members only. Net-score play requires a USGA handicap. A Super Seniors event will also be held for players over 70 years of age.
