Golf Committee Notes

The golf course is in wonderful condition so get out to the Lodge and participate in the following events scheduled for May and June:

Saturday, May 7th – Derby Days is always one of our most popular tournaments of the year. Teams made up of A, B, C and D handicapped players are formed by the Pro Shop. Parimutuel betting, it is Kentucky Derby weekend after all, is available for this event. Sign-up in the Pro Shop and make a bet on your favorite teams. Breakfast is served prior to play. Event is open to golf members only with a USGA handicap.

Tuesday, May 3rd – Ladies, it's the first Super Tuesday of the season. It will be a SOCK HOP, does that mean Bobbie Socks? Shot gun start at 5:30, Dinner to follow. Get signed-up in Pro Shop.

Tuesday, June 7th – Ladies Super Tuesday event.

Saturday, June 18th – Junior Golf Championship will play contested. Please sign-up your junior golfer in Pro Shop. Open to children of Elk members who are 17-years of age or under.

Saturday and Sunday, June 25th & 26th – Elks Lodge 590 Men's Club Championship will be contested. Champion is player with lowest gross-score over 36-holes of play. We also play an individual net-score event as part of tournament. Club Championship is open to men golf members only. Net-score play requires a USGA handicap.

Elk's Ladies 2016 News:

The kickoff meeting was held on the 19th of April, a fun schedule was set for the season.

Some reminders: Always check in at the Pro Shop, pay for your round, cart, and see what holes will have flag prizes on them. You must be a member of the Ladies Golf league to be eligible to win prizes. Skins game is optional to play, you must have a current USGA handicap, and the cost is \$20.00 per person. The Elks club will bill you if interested. If you play 18 holes on a Tuesday, the first 9 holes count as your league score towards holes prizes. Keep your true score on your card as you play, circle your birdies and put a birdie on the birdie tree in the ladies locker room.

There will be games every Tuesday for the ladies. This year will be active and fun!

Dues for the season remain at \$35.00; pay the Elks.

Super Tuesday with dinner cost is \$25.00; pay the Elks.

To all golfers maintaining an IGA handicap at our Lodge:

The active score posting season for the IGA (Iowa Golf Association) region begins on Friday, April 1st. Acceptable scores made on courses within the IGA region between the dates of April 1st through October 31st must be posted for handicap purposes.

The IGA invoices the Lodge based on the number of active adult golfers on our handicap roster as of the May 15th revision date. To ensure we have an accurate roster for IGA billing, we will deactivate any golfer that hasn't paid their \$20 handicap fee by May 1st. Please make sure you have notified us of your wish to maintain a handicap and have your Year 2016 handicap fee of \$20 paid no later than May 1st.

Elks Lodge 590 Pool Rules & Policies

- ALL food and/or beverages consumed in the pool area MUST be purchased from the Club. No coolers.
- Children under the age of 12 must NOT be left unattended by their parents. (Lifeguards are there to work, not to baby-sit.)
- 3. No gum chewing allowed in the pool area.
- 4. No band-aids in the pool.
- 5. Swimsuits are the only acceptable attire for pool use. No T-shirts allowed in the pool. (T-shirts only have an SPF of 5, a good sunscreen is a much better idea.) No cutoffs. No aqua socks in the pool. (They are the second largest source for contaminates in the swimming pools)
- 6. No large rafts or inflatable toys allowed in the pool. Small balls, water rings, are OK. No inflatable devices in the deep end EVER.
- 7. No tennis balls, footballs, etc. The only objects allowed are "Nerf" or soft objects only.
- 8. There is to be no swimming in the deep end without free swim called (i.e.: Lifeguards can only allow either swimming or diving, NOT both.)
- Children are allowed in the deep end only after they exhibit the ability to swim the length of the deep end twice IN GOOD FORM.
- Patrons must swim directly to the side ladder to get out of the deep end. Not back underneath the diving board.
- 11. One person on the diving board at a time.

- 12. One bounce on the diving board and then into the water. This means you cannot drop to buttocks and then into the water. Either feet first or hands first.
- 13. No running is allowed on the pool deck.
- 14. No horse playing or chicken fights.
- 15. No back dives or flips from the side of the pool.
- 16. NO GLASS containers of any kind in the pool deck area.
- 17. No hanging on the diving board.
- 18. No hanging on the ropes in the pool.
- 19. Adult swim will be called every hour and will last ten minutes. During this time all children (under age 18 years) must clear the water completely this means get all the way out of the water.
- 20. Everyone MUST sign in when entering the pool area.
- 21. A \$5.00 per person fee must be paid or charged by all Regular Lodge Members who are not Season Swimming Members and their guest.
- 22. Nannies and baby-sitters are considered members of the family of pool members and will not need to pay the swim fee.
- 23. Patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- 24. Lifeguards are the FINAL authority in the pool areas. This means that the guards can sit people out of the pool for ten minutes, the day, the week, etc.
